The Class Teacher will:

- teach high quality effective series of lessons so all pupils make good progress;
- achieve the highest possible standards in work and conduct;
- maintain the positive ethos and core values of the school with honesty and integrity;
- ensure that the current national conditions of employment for school teachers are met.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

The Class Teacher will:

- be accountable for pupils' attainment, progress, and outcomes;
- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of how children learn;
- have a secure knowledge of the foundation stage and primary age curriculum and the teaching of early reading, including phonics and mathematical fluency;
- set goals that stretch and challenge pupils of all backgrounds, abilities, and dispositions;
- know when and how to personalise learning appropriately, using approaches which enable high quality learning for all;
- have a clear understanding of how to meet the needs of vulnerable learners, including those with special educational needs;
- provide a stimulating classroom environment to foster a love of learning;
- keep appropriate and efficient records, integrating formative and summative assessment into weekly and termly planning;
- demonstrate attention to detail and the ability to maximise all learning opportunities;
- communicate effectively with parents on the development, progress, and attainment of pupils;
- have high expectations for learning attitudes and behaviour, in accordance with the school's behaviour policy;
- deploy support staff effectively;
- take responsibility for improving teaching through appropriate professional development and appraisal;
- make a positive contribution to the wider life and ethos of the school;
- have strong subject knowledge and, if appropriate, co-ordinate a curriculum area across the school;
- implement agreed school policies and guidelines.

Other Requirements:
