Job title: Maintenance Technician

#### **Purpose and impact**

The role of the Maintenance Technician is to assist in maintaining the Swimming Pool, buildings, equipment and machinery within the Centre to ensure that all facilities are running efficiently and are available to the general public.

#### **Key responsibilities**

- Provide maintenance support.
- Identify, repair, isolate or replace where possible, all maintenance defects in Dorset Council facilities.
- Carry out day to day reactive maintenance of mechanical equipment, plant and buildings.
- Carry out daily, monthly and quarterly inspections of all alarms systems, equipment, tools, mechanical equipment and protective clothing when required.
- Ensure safe working practices are adhered to throughout.
- Ensure that the swimming pool facilities are fully maintained in accordance with Health and Safety legislation.
- Carry out daily/weekly/monthly pool water testing including micro biological and record as required.
- Ensure all chemical levels are correct and adjust as necessary.
- Ensure the swimming pools are backwashed in accordance with the normal operating procedures for each leisure site.
- Monitor, service and maintain swimming pool plant.
- Maintain an up to date Records Management system.
- Record and maintain records of maintenance tasks and inspections that are compliant with current legislation.
- Maintain accurate records of all maintenance works undertaken.
- Provide an audit trail for all maintenance tasks and inspections.
- Report, log and where possible rectify all health and safety issues and concerns.
- Ensure that all Health and Safety legislation is adhered to.
- Ensure all essential qualifications are up to date and undertake where possible Continuous Professional Development in relevant areas.
- Be knowledgeable in all aspects of relevant legislation and how this relates to the facilities across Dorset Council, e.g. Health and Safety at Work Act, Working at Height, and Provision and use of Work Equipment Regulations etc.
- Ensure all maintenance tasks and equipment complies with the relevant Health and Safety legislation to ensure the safety of operatives, staff and public.
- Ensure at all times when working the safety of public, staff and operatives.

NB: The duties and responsibilities of this post are not restrictive and the post holder may be required on occasion to undertake other duties. This will not substantially change the nature of the post.
