An impressive capacity to cater for extremely different academic needs in a nurturing environment. No wonder it's oversubscribed."





We are outward-looking, with strong community links and excellent collaboration with other good and outstanding schools regionally and nationally. We are a comprehensive school serving a diverse community. Teaching is often outstanding, consistently at least good across all subjects and key stages. Pastoral care and discipline are described as "excellent," and students demonstrate reflective thinking, courtesy, and a commitment to improving their school community.

The Gryphon achieves high academic results at GCSE and A Level, and our Sixth Form of 400 students has an outstanding record of university placements, including Oxford, Cambridge, Russell Group universities, apprenticeships, and professional training.

In May 2022, our SIAMS inspection judged us Excellent as a Church School, and Ofsted (June 2023) confirmed our status as a good school. Education here goes beyond exam results; we focus on personal development, ensuring students leave as well-rounded young people with a sense of social, moral, and cultural responsibility. Digital learning is an important aspect of our provision, with mobile technology integrated to enhance learning while encouraging responsible use.
